- HP will continue to provide full technical support for Tru64 UNIX Alpha Server systems through the end of 2012. In addition, Mature Product Support will continue to be available from HP as described below.
- Tru64 UNIX releases and their Engineering Support dates are as follows:
  - Tru64 UNIX V5.1B-4: Engineering Support, including work on customer defects, code changes and release patches to resolve customer defects ended October 31, 2010.
  - Tru64 UNIX V5.1B-5: Engineering Support, including work on customer defects, code changes and release patches to resolve customer defects, will be available until December 31, 2012.
  - Tru64 UNIX V5.1B-6: Released in October 2010. Engineering Support, including work on customer defects, code changes and release patches to resolve customer defects, will be available until December 31, 2012.
  - With the release of Tru64 UNIX V5.1B-6, Tru64 UNIX has entered the Mature Product Support stage with Sustaining Engineering (MPS with SE) beginning November 1, 2010.
- HP will provide Mature Product support without Sustaining Engineering (MPS without SE) beginning January 1, 2013. Support contracts will be migrated automatically with

prior notification from HP.
